

Victorian coat

crochet pattern
coat hat and muff



Designed by
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4 ply worsted weight yarn about 20oz about 2 oz for contrast.

K hook

6, 1-1¼” buttons

Guage working hdc 8 sts=3” 4 rows=2”

Ch 67, hdc in 3rd ch from hook and each ch across
Rows 2-3 ch 2 turn, hdc in each st across

Left back

Row 4 ch 2 turn, hdc in next 15 sts

Row 5, ch 2 turn skip 1st hdc, hdc in each st across

Rows 6-10 ch 2 turn hdc in each hdc across

Row 11, ch 2 turn, hdc in next 9 sts, sc in next st

Row 12 turn slst in next 2 sts, sc in next st, hdc in next 7 sts

Row 13, ch 2 turn hdc in each hdc across

Finish off

Center back

Row 4, working in row 3 skip 1 hdc, attach yarn with slst and ch 2 in the next hdc, hdc in same st and next 32 sts

Row 5, ch 2 turn skip first st, hdc in each st across to last 2 sts, hdc last 2 sts together

Rows 6-11 ch 2 hdc in each hdc across

Row 12, hdc in next 8 sts, dc in next 15 sts, hdc in last 8 sts

Row 13 ch 2 turn, hdc in next 8 hdc, slst in each sc, hdc in last 8 hdc

Finish off

Right Front

Working in remaining sts from row 3 join yarn in second sts

Row 4 ch 3 hdc in each hdc across

Row 5 ch 2 hdc across to last 2 sts, hdc last 2 sts tog

Rows 6-10 ch 2 turn, hdc in each st across

Row 11 slst in next 4 sts, sc in next st, hdc in each st across

Row 12 ch 2 turn, hdc in next 8 sts, sc in last st

Row 13, slst in next 2 sts, ch 1 hdc in each st across

Finish off

Sew shoulder seams

Inset

Working in free loops from base chain join with slst in 1st st. ch 8 turn, sc in each ch across (7sc) working again in ch on bodice slst in next 2 ch turn

Row 2 sc in each sc across

Row 3 ch 1 turn sc in next 7 sc, slst in next 2 ch on bodice

Repeat rows 2&3 across to end of bodice

Turn and slst in each sc across

Row 1 ch 3 working in side of sc, work 2 dc in each sc across

Rows 2-17, ch 3 turn dc in each dc across

Row 18 ch 1 turn, sc in same st (skip next 2 dc, ch 2, 2dc in next st skip 2 sts sc in next st) repeat across. You will have

to do some adjusting to make the pattern go right it is shy by 3 sts (do NOT finish off)

Button hole band

Row 1 working in sides of skirt and bodice work 32 sc evenly across to neck

row 2 ch 1 turn sc in 1st st, ch 2 skip 2 sts (sc in next 5 sts, ch 2 skip 2 sts) repeat 5 more times, sc across to end.

Row 3 ch 1 turn sc in each sc and ch across

Row 4 ch 1 turn, sc in each sc across

Finish off

Button band

Join yarn with slst at neck edge with right sides facing

Row 1 work 32 sc evenly across

Rows 2-4, ch 1 turn sc in each sc across

Finish off

Collar

Working in neck opening with right sides facing join yarn with slst in second st

Row 1 ch 1 work 35 sc evenly across to other side

Row 2 ch 1 turn, sc in each sc across

Row 3 ch 1 turn sc in next sc 2 sc in next sc, sc in each st across to last 2 sc, 2 sc in nest sc, sc in last

Rows 4-5 ch 1 turn sc in each st across

Row 6 repeat row 3

Rows 7-8 repeat rows 4 & 5

Row 9 repeat row 3

Rows 10-12 ch 1 turn sc across

Row 13 Ch 1 turn, sc in next sc, sc next 2 tog, sc across to last 3 sts, sc next 2 tog, sc in next st

Row 14, ch 1 sc in each st across

Row 15, ch 1 turn, sk 1st sc, sc next 2 tog, sc across to last 3 sc, draw up a loop in next st, sk next st, draw up a loop in the last st, yo and draw through all 3 loops

Finish off

Sleeves (make 2)

Ch 7 sc in 2nd ch from hook and each ch across

(ch 1 turn, sc in each sc across) repeat until you have 26 rows

row 1 working along sides of sc work 22 hdc evenly across

row 2-3 ch 2 turn, hdc in each sc across

row 4 ch 2 turn hdc in next st, work 2 hdc in next, hdc across to last 2 hdc, 2 hdc in next, hdc in last st

rows 5-7 Ch 2 turn, sc in each st across

repeat rows 4-7 until you have 20 rows

row 21, slst in next 3 sts, sc in next st, hdc in each st across to last 3 sts, sc in next st

row 22, slst in next sc and hdc, ch 1 hdc in each st across to last 2 hdc, sc in next st

repeat row 22 until you have 4 hdc left

finish off

sew sleeve together except the single crochet cuff, that is up to you if you want to sew it. I personally left mine unsewn

sew sleeves to sleeve opening

Now you may decorate your jacket as desired. On the one pictures I have work sc around collar, down button band, across back bottom and up button hole band and I also put it around the cuffs. To work the ch embellishment have the right side facing you, hold the yarn under the coat and the hook above. Put the hook through the desired space and pull up a loop, put the hook in the next desired space and pull yarn through loop, continue until you have desired effect.

Hat

ch 5 slst to 1 ch to form a ring (ch 3 same as dc)

Rnd 1 ch 3, work 12 dc in ring, slst to top of ch 3

Rnd 2 ch 3, work 2 dc in each dc across, slst to top

Rnd 3, ch 3, (2 dc in next st, dc in next st) around slst to top

Rnd 4, ch 3 (2 dc in next st, dc in next 2 sts) repeat around, slst to top

Rnd 5, ch 3 (2 dc in next st, dc in nest 3 sts) repeat around, slst to top

Rnd 6, ch 3 (2 dc in next st, dc in next 4 sts) repeat around, slst to top

Rnd 7, ch 3 dc in each dc around, slst to top

Rnd 8, (dc next 2 sts tog, dc in next 3 sts) repeat around, slst to top

Rnd 9, (dc nest 2 sts tog, dc in nest 2 sts) repeat around, slst to top

Rnd 10, sc in each dc around, slst to top of first sc

Rnds 11-13, sc in each sc around slst to top of first sc

Finish off, (embellish as desired)

Hand Muff

Row 1, ch 32 skip 2 ch work hdc in each ch across

Rows 2-19, ch 2 turn hdc in each hdc across

Finish off sew side seams tog

For handle join yarn inbetween second and 3rd rows about 7 sts from edge, ch enough to comfortably fit around neck and have the muff rest somewhere between the hips and waist. I did 91. now on opposite side in the 7st from edge between row 17 and 18 slst being careful not to twist ch, ch 3 slst in the 7st from edge in next row down work dc in each ch across, slst to the 7th st in the next row up. Finish off, embellish as desired.
